



## Reopening of Club

Please observe the following guidelines when considering using the range as from Thursday 21st May:

1. Familiarise yourself with the guidelines as issued by Archery GB. [Click here to go to website.](#)
2. Use only even numbered lanes (lane 2 max 50m).
3. ONE archer per lane (2 if a fellow family member).
4. When setting up and returning targets use gloves.
5. The Club has provided *limited* hand sanitiser, wipes and gloves. Please use as necessary but **bring your own** PPE. Using your own PPE will obviously safeguard you better. You are responsible for your own personal virus protection.
6. The kitchen is off-limits for food or drink preparation. Please bring your own refreshments.
7. Bring your own target pins/faces if possible.
8. Disinfect all surfaces, door handles, keypad, etc.
9. Observe social distancing at all times.
10. Use WhatsApp and other forms of communication to advise your intentions to shoot. (We will monitor the attendance and put in place a booking system if deemed necessary)
11. Shoot during working, or less popular, hours if possible to avoid congestion.
12. Submit any score sheets electronically if possible. Send to [records@chichester-bowmen.co.uk](mailto:records@chichester-bowmen.co.uk)
13. Please do not regard the club as a social gathering facility. Turn up, shoot and go home!
14. Minimise the number of members setting-up/taking-down the flags and make sure you use gloves.
15. Leave the clubhouse doors open when the range is in use - less requirements to disinfect those handles.
16. Set up your bows OUTSIDE. Please do not use the clubhouse for anything other than toilet and hand-washing.
17. Indoor shooting is currently banned, please do not be tempted.
18. Chichester Bowmen is very much in the public eye. Please do not give any park users cause to point fingers. The club needs its reputation.

Infection is most likely via surfaces. Touching an infected surface and then your face will put you at risk. Wipe all surfaces, wash your hands regularly and try not to touch your face. Club members **must** notify the club should they develop symptoms of the virus after attending the archery range.

**DO NOT USE THE CLUBHOUSE FOR ANYTHING OTHER THAN ESSENTIAL PERSONAL HYGIENE.**

Please consider yourselves and others. Chichester Bowmen cannot guarantee a sterile, no-risk experience. We would ask members to fully consider their personal risk and risk to others before attending.
