Where?	LONGHILL SPORTS CENTRE. Longhill High School, Falmer Road, Rottingdean, BN2 7FR
When?	SUNDAY JANUARY 29 <sup>th</sup> , 2023: Assembly at 9.30am, finish approx. 2pm
How?	40 places available, return entry form <u><a href="#">below</a></u> by January 15 <sup>th</sup> 2023
How much?	<b><u>Free</u></b> to SCAA members

In the morning session juniors will face a number of fun archery challenges designed to test their skills, flexibility and wits. Zombies, twister, horseback, breaking stuff, battleships, and other things we have not completely tested yet await. Not your average archery session...

After the lunch break there will be a 36 arrow round, shot in ends of 3 arrows. A selection of target faces will be available at 18 metres, with a 10 metre distance available for any juniors who would prefer to shoot at that distance. Medals will be awarded according to ArcheryGB categories.

Best of all, this whole shoot is free. **Places are limited to 40 juniors on a first come first served basis**, so get your entries in quickly (entry forms must be in by January 15<sup>th</sup> 2023).

SCAA is very grateful to Brighton Bowmen for partnering with us to host this event.

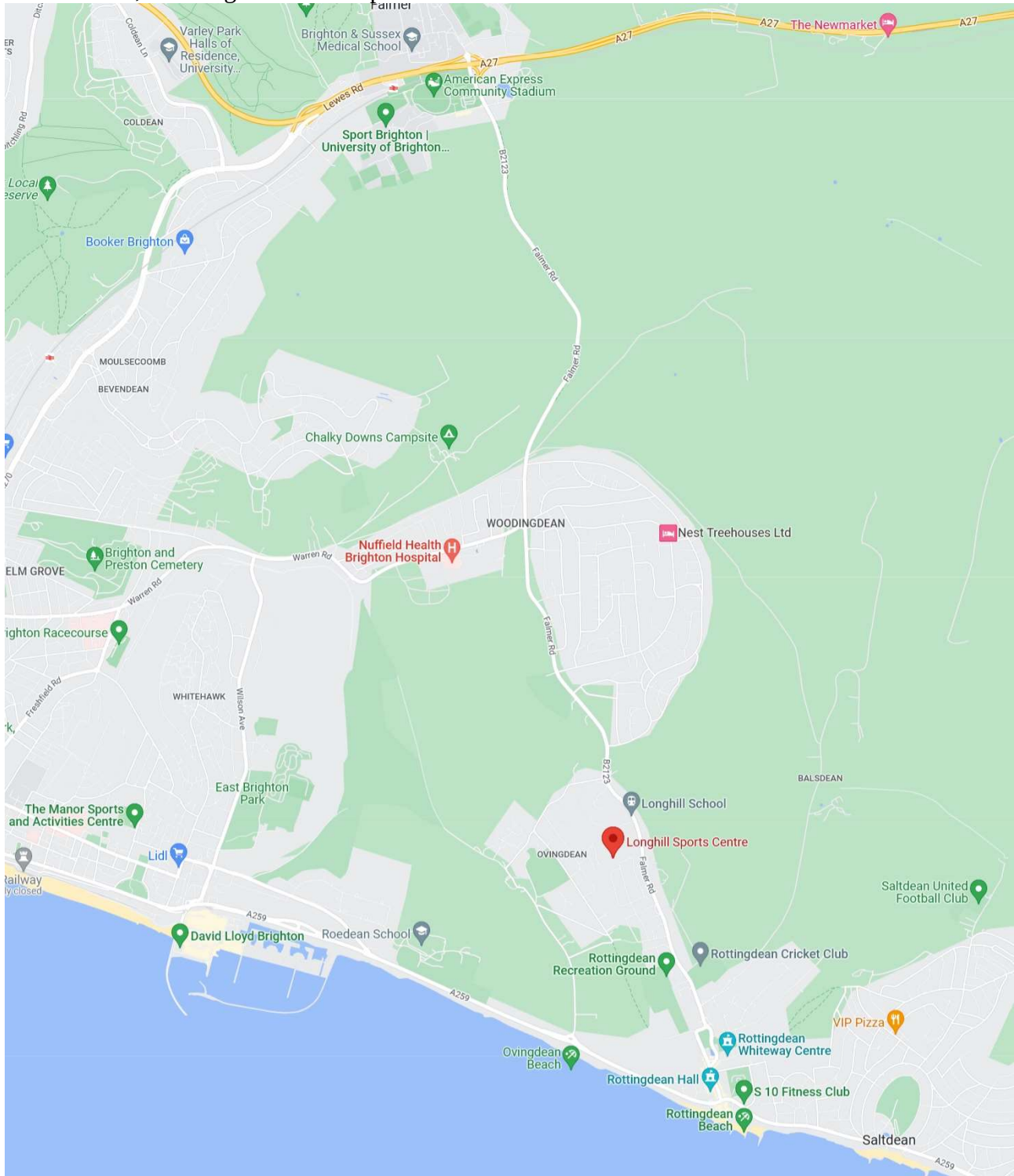
Longhill Sports Centre will be serving hot/cold drinks and snacks on the day, but please bring your own lunch.

Please **aim to arrive at Longhill Sports Centre no later than 9.15am** so archers have time to set up their bows ahead of assembly at 9.30am and a start to shooting shortly after.

**Photography:** In accordance with the AGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at the event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival at the venue. entering the tournament, participants (and / or their parents / guardians) confirm agreement to this policy. Local Newspapers and TV or Radio Stations may send reporters who may have different standards that SCAA cannot be held responsible for.

**Archer's special requirements:** If you have any special needs such as space for a tactile sight, wheelchair, stool or electric buggy, or space for a helper dog, or a privacy tent, etc, please indicate on the form. If you need more space to write your requirement please just use the blank part of the form. If you use a wheelchair or similar but are able to get to and from the line readily in the time allowance, the Tournament Organiser would appreciate if you say so in case there is exceptional demand for places, although generally wheelchair etc users will be allocated both details.

**Data Protection opt-in:** By entering this competition, entrants affirm they agree to their personal details being used to compile the Entrants / Target lists and Results Sheets, which will be published and may be archived for posterity. Address and Contact information will not be shared with others, and will be kept in accordance with the SCAA Privacy Policy. Entrants also agree that address data may be held for up to 3 years and be used to publicise future archery events, but may opt-out of receiving publicity communications by contacting the Tournament Organiser and requesting removal from the list.

**Supervision:** For juniors under the age of 11 a parent or designated responsible adult must be present throughout the event. If the adult responsible for a junior aged between 11 and 18 wishes not to remain with that young person during this event, they must (a) remain with the young person until the event commences, (b) must not leave the young person without gaining the prior consent of the Junior Team Manager, and (c) must collect the young person at the end of the event.
